**ITINERARY**

**Day 1: TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT**

Depart CLT airport for transatlantic flight.

**Day 2: HADERA**

**Welcome to Israel!** Touchdown at Ben Gurion Airport. We will be met by our Christian tour guide. Transfer to our hotel in Hadera.

**Day 3: TIBERIAS**

After breakfast, we travel to **Caesarea** and visit the spectacular **Roman Theater** and **Roman Aqueduct**. Continue on to **Haifa** and visit **Stella Maris**, where **Prophet Elijah** prayed for rain. Continue on to **Nazareth**, where we visit the **Church of the Annunciation**. We end the day at **Caná**, where we renew our marriage vows at the **Church of the Wedding Feast**. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.



**Day 4: TIBERIAS**

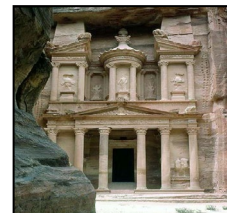
We begin the day with a **boat ride in the Sea of Galilee**, then we continue on to **Tabgha**, the traditional site of the multiplication of loaves and fish. Continue to the **Mensa Christi**, where Jesus restored Peter back to Himself. Proceed to **Capernaum**, where we visit the **Synagogue of Jesus** and the **House of Peter**. We end the day in **Mount Tabor**, the traditional site of the transfiguration of Jesus. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

**Day 5: TIBERIAS**

Visit **Magdala**, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. We continue on to visit **Mount Beatitudes**, where Jesus preached the **Sermon on the Mount**. We proceed to **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus asked, he asked his disciples: "Who do people say the Son of Man is? We end the day in **Tel Dan**, a significant place in the Old Testament.

**Day 6: AMMAN**

After breakfast, we proceed to **Jordan River**, where we renew our baptismal vows. We cross the **Sheikh Hussein Bridge** to **Jordan** and meet our guide. Then proceed to **Madaba**, well known for its ancient and most complete mosaic map of **Jordan** and the **Holy Land**, and to **Mt Nebo**, the resting place of **Moses**. Dinner and overnight in **Amman**.



**Day 7: PETRA / AMMAN**

Early morning drive to **Petra**, the ancient city of the Nabateans. Start from the visitor's center riding your horses to the **Dam**, then continue on foot through the **Siq**, a long narrow gorge to the **Treasury**, the **Theater**, the **Court**, and the **Roman**

**Columns in the Basin**. Enjoy the splendor of the meticulously carved massive structures out of the rose-colored sandstone. Dinner and overnight in **Amman**.

**Day 8: DEAD SEA**

After breakfast, we cross the border to **Israel** and proceed to **Jericho**, where we visit the oldest city in the world conquered by **Joshua**, the **Sycamore Tree** and the **Mount of Temptation**. We continue to the **Dead Sea** and enjoy floating in the water. Dinner and overnight by the **Dead Sea**.



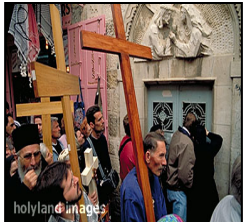
**DAY 9: JERUSALEM**

Early morning departure to **Mt. Sodom**, and then view **Qumran**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered. Then we visit the **Wailing Wall**, considered as the holiest site for the Jews. We continue on to **Bethlehem** and visit the **Church of the Nativity**, where Jesus was born, and **St. Jerome's Grotto**. We end the day singing Christmas carols at the **Shepherds' Field**. Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem**.



**DAY 10: JERUSALEM**

We begin the day at **Mount of Olives** and visit the **Church of Pater Noster** and **Dominus Flevit**, where Jesus wept over **Jerusalem**. Descend on foot to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. After lunch, we proceed to **Mount Zion**, and visit the **Upper Room**, where Jesus had the **Last Supper**, then proceed to **Dormition Abbey**. We end the day at the **Church of St Peter in Gallicantu**, believed to be the location of the High Priest's **Caiphas Palace**. Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem**.



**DAY 11: JERUSALEM**

We begin the day at **Bethesda Pool**, where Jesus healed the paralytic man. We continue to the **Church of Condemnation and Flagellation**, where we begin the **Via Dolorosa** and follow the footsteps of our Lord on His way to **Calvary**, ending at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**, where we visit **Golgotha** and the **tomb of Jesus**. We travel to **Ein Kerem**, and visit the birthplace of **John the Baptist**; ascend on foot to the **Church of the Visitation**, where Mary visited **Elizabeth**. Dinner and overnight in **Jerusalem**.
