## ITINERARY

### DAY 1, SEP 14: DEPART USA

Depart from USA for transatlantic flight. Meals will be provided aboard the airplane.

### DAY 2, SEP 15: MEDJUGORJE

Welcome to Croatia! Meet our Tour Director and transfer to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Medjugorje.

### DAY 3 and 4, SEP 16-17: MEDJUGORJE

After breakfast, tour of Old Town of Dubrovnik, including visit of St. Blaise church. Drive to Medjugorje to check-in to our hotel for 2 nights. While in Medjugorje, the group will visit the **Apparition Hill** and climb **Holy Cross Mountain**. Meetings with visionaries will be scheduled, if possible. In the evenings, attend the recitation of the Rosary and the Healing service at **St. James church**. During the day you have the opportunity for confession or to spend time in prayer in the Perpetual Adoration Chapel. Dinner and overnight in Medjugorje.



### DAY 5, SEP 18: SPLIT

After breakfast, drive to Split. Upon arrival, enjoy sightseeing of the **Diocletian Palace** with your local guide. Dinner and overnight in Split.

### DAY 6, SEP 19: ZAGREB

This morning, travel to Zagreb and enjoy a city tour featuring the historic upper town, **St. Mark's church**, with the most colourful roof You have ever seen, Open Market with local groceries and some hand made things and Ban Jelačić Square. One of Zagreb's jewelleryers is its famous Stone Gate, Zagreb's most important shrine praising the Mother of God. Dinner and overnight in Zagreb.

### DAY 7, SEP 20: SALZBURG

Long transfer from Zagreb to Salzburg, on route stop in Bled for lunch time (short stop). Late arrival to Salzburg. Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.

### DAY 8, SEP 21: PRAGUE

In the morning, get to know Salzburg - it is a picturesque city known for its baroque architecture and rich musical history, the world-famous composer W.A. Mozart was born here. You will visit beautiful **Mirabell Gardens** and the historic centre, learn about the history of "**The Sounds of Music**" city, about archbishops and about significant pilgrimage trails laid around Salzburg, St James's Way being arguably one of the most famous pilgrimage routes in this region. In the afternoon, you will have departure to Prague. Late arrival to Prague. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

### DAY 9, SEP 22: PRAGUE

This morning, tour the old part of the city to view the old town square, the famous Astronomical clock, the Jewish quarter, St. Nicholas church, Charles bridge and the Carmelite church of our Lady Victorious to see **Infant Jesus of Prague**. Your afternoon and evening are at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Prague.



### DAY 10, SEP 23: KRAKOW

Morning departure with the bus Krakow Poland. On the way you will make a stop at Olomouc for lunch and some free time to explore the town by yourself and then continue to Krakow. You will reach Krakow in the late

afternoon and have evening at leisure. For individual activities, we suggest visiting Saint Wenceslas Cathedral in Olomouc. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

### DAY 11, SEP 24: KRAKOW

During today's morning walking tour, you will visit the Main Market Square in Krakow, the biggest Medieval old town square in Europe. In the Old Town you will find the **Wawel Hill** - with the **Cathedral and the Royal Castle, Town Hall Tower, St. Mary's Basilica, Krakow Barbican** and Sukiennice (Cloth Hall), thousands of coffee places and delightful regional restaurants, many historic buildings and horse-driven cabs. Later on, you will continue to **Wieliczka Salt Mine**, the mysterious salt labyrinth that dates back to the Middle Ages and is the world's longest active salt mine. Dinner and overnight Krakow.

### DAY 12, SEP 25: KRAKOW

Today you have departure with the bus from Krakow to Warsaw, visiting **Auschwitz-Birkenau** concentration camp on the way. The concentration camp in Auschwitz was established by German Nazis in 1940 and after the war it was turned into museum displaying evidence of the genocide. Follow the steps of the WWII and see Block no. 11, known as the Death Block, where people were murdered, also the "Wall of Death". Outside the camp, you will see a gas chamber, where 70,000 people were killed during the war. In the afternoon we will stop at **Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy** in Krakow Lagiewniki. Sanctuary of the Divine Mercy is one of the most important sanctuaries in the world that will encourage us to pray and contemplate Divine Mercy by the grave of Saint Sister Faustina and the Jesus, In You I Trust painting. Dinner and overnight Krakow.



### DAY 13, SEP 26: WARSAW

This morning, journey to Czestochowa and visit the Yasna Gora monastery, known for the blackened picture of the virgin mary, popularly called the **'Black Madonna.'** in the late afternoon, arrive in Poland's capital city, Warsaw. Dinner and overnight.

### DAY 13, SEP 27: WARSAW

Your sightseeing tour here includes a drive along the famous royal route from magnificent castle square to Lazienki park and palace, the summer residence of the last king of Poland. Pass by the palace of science and culture (known as the "wedding cake"), the Saxon gardens, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, monument to the heroes of the Warsaw ghetto, and barbican. Continue with a walking tour of the Old town, Old market square and St. John's cathedral. The rest of the day is free for shopping or a stroll through the city. Dinner and overnight.



### DAY 14, SEP 28: WARSAW / USA

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to USA.
