ITINERARY

DEC 10: MANILA

Embark ship at 8:00P.

DEC 11: BORACAY (9:00A – 5:00P tender port)

A destination so popular, Boracay is a favorite for a reason. The White Beach is this small island's most famous feature. The water is usually clear, warm and inviting. After relaxing on the beach, take a stroll through open air markets.

DEC 12: PUERTO PRINCESA (7:00A – 5:00P)

Puerto Princesa is full of history, nature, good food and relaxing beaches. If you're feeling adventurous, check out the Subterranean River – a Unesco World Heritage site.

DEC 13: CORON (7:00A - 4:00P)

Coron Town is located in the eastern portion of Busuanga Island and is an ideal base from which to discover the awe-inspiring natural beauty of the Calamian Islands. The main attractions are hot springs.

DEC 14: AT SEA

DEC 15: HONGKONG (arrive 9:00A)

This former British colony brims with modern skyscrapers, ancient traditions and incredible food. The highest point in the city, Victoria Peak, offers sweeping views of this vibrant city. Overnight in Hongkong.

DEC 16: HONGKONG (depart 4:00P)

A shopper's paradise, local shops and markets offer everything imaginable – from silk to jewelry and electronics. As Asia's culinary capital, your gastronomic desires are sure to be fulfilled.

DEC 17: KAOHSIUNG, TAIWAN (11:00A – 8:00P)

Colonization by the Dutch in the 17th century has left an ample architectural legacy, as did Taiwan's rule by Japan from 1895-1945. Art lovers can enjoy the outdoors and contemporary sculptures at the Kaohsiung Museum of Fine Arts' Sculpture Park.

DEC 18: HUALIEN, TAIWAN (9:00A – 5:00P)

The gateway to the east coast of Taiwan, Hualien is a bustling city full of good food, majestic architecture and beautiful green spaces. Tour temples both old and new, stroll through the city center or get a taste of Taiwan at one of the many restaurants or markets.

DEC 19: MIYAKOJIMA (OKINAWA) (7:00A – 5:00P tender port)

Pacific perfection awaits at Miyakojima in Okinawa Prefecture. This Japanese island paradise is known for its natural beauty and vibrant local culture. Stop by the beaches of Sunayama or Aragusuku for sunshine and snorkeling.

DEC 20: NAHA (OKINAWA) (7:00A – 5:00P)

Enjoy the scenic countryside, the WWII memorials, magnificent limestone caves and a reconstructed Ryukyu village where the island's heritage and crafts are on display. Take home exquisite Bingata fabric, handmade paper, colorful tsuboya-yaki pottery and other craft items. You'll also find foods to suit any palate, but traditional Okinawan cuisine blends influences from Chinese and Southeast Asian cuisines.

DEC 21: ISHIGAKI, JAPAN (7:00A – 5:00P tender port)

Discover this remote and picturesque island's lush mountains, beautiful beaches and magnificent coral reef from island viewpoints. See the native palm forest and lavishly decorated Chinese tomb. Search for local textiles, pottery, crafts and black pearls and enjoy local meat – centered specialties in the town's restaurants.

DEC 22: TAIPEI, TAIWAN (7:00A disembark)

The capital of this fascinating island, once known as Formosa ("beautiful island" in Portuguese) has a rich aboriginal, colonial and political history. Snap a selfie at the ornate, dragon-adorned Mengjia Longshang Temple or photograph the changing of the guard at Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall, a must-see site. Experience 360-degree views of the city from the 91st floor observation deck of Taipei 101.
